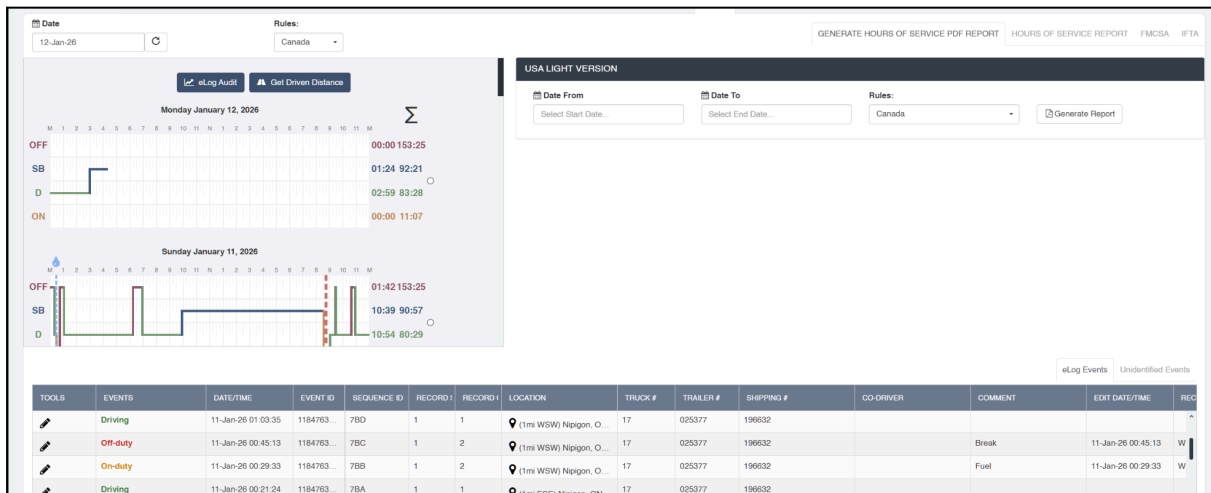
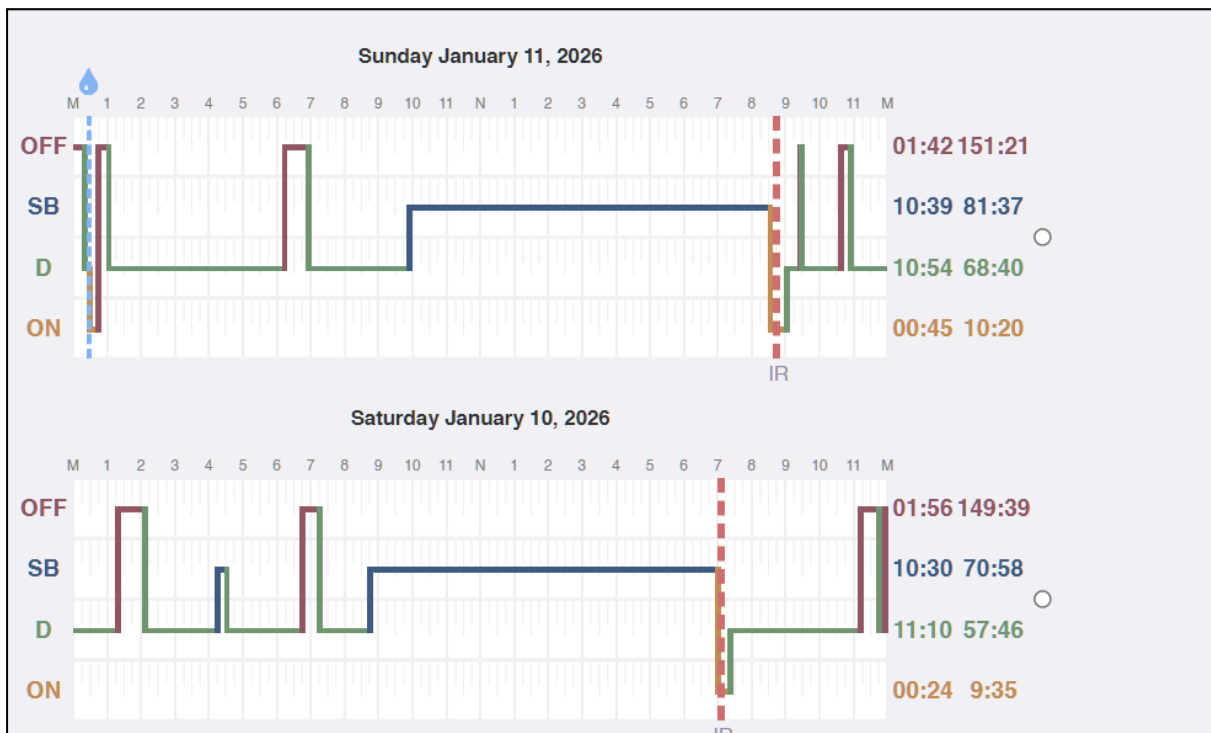


HOS

The **HOS** tab is located on the **Driver Profile** page. On the top left corner you can see a date picker. Pick the date within the 6 months period and click the update button, the RODS will be updated and you will see the events for the selected date and the previous 14 days.



The graph on the left shows changes in duty statuses for 15 days plus one duty status, thus the graph doesn't start with an empty space.



Event list and editing tools

At the bottom of the **HOS** tab (Driver Profile page) you will see the list of events according to the selected date on the top of the page, for 15 days plus one duty status (the one which prevents the graph from having an empty space at the beginning of the period).

Use scroll to see all the data available for the events.

In the first column titled **Tools** you can find editing tools available for Fleet Manager (note that only events certified by a driver can be edited by fleet managers). After editing the event you must wait for the driver's response on your edit suggestion, until that moment tools for that particular event will be disabled (to avoid multiple edit suggestions for the same event at the same time).

Also tools can not be applied if editing period affects the period which already has other edit suggestions with no driver's response yet (e.g. you will not be able to transfer Personal Use to the co-driver if the co-driver has the edit suggestion to change Off-Duty status to another duty status at that moment).

Active events are colored, inactive events are gray.

Click on the black Pencil icon to edit event information, such as:

- Duty Status (note that driving time can not be shortened, please use a comment to inform an inspector that Driving duty status is meant to be non-driving status if needed);
- Trailer Number (up to 3 trailers);
- Location Description (pick the country first to select the state/province and then fill in the city, system will suggest you existing cities, but you still can enter any location you want);
- Comment (note that it's not possible to save the edits without entering the comment, even if the comment was originally there, you must re-enter it).

Re-assign driving time to co-driver



Click on the black Paper Plane icon to re-assign driving time to co-driver.

Transfer tool is available only for Driving, Personal Use and Yard Move events which were recorded during the team driving period.

Transfer from the current driver is available only to the one particular driver (to the co-driver who was logged in the system as the second driver).
